SUNUNU ANNOUNCES \$3.9 MILLION FUNDING PACKAGE FOR NORTH CONWAY WATER PRECINCT

WASHINGTON, D.C. - United States Senator John Sununu (R-NH) announced today (2/27) that the North Conway Water Precinct is set to receive \$3.9 million through the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Water and Waste Disposal Land and Grant Program. The funding package, which includes a \$2.1 million loan and a grant of \$1.8 million, aims to extend service to new customers and improve water quality and reliability.

"These resources will help advance plans to upgrade local water and sewer infrastructure, which officials have identified as a priority," said Sununu. "Approval of this funding package also brings good news for taxpayers. Combining Water Precinct projects with planned road improvements will help deliver significant cost savings to the community."

Funds provided through the loan and grant will be used for a project to install gravity sewer lines on Intervale Cross Road, Kearsarge Road, Mechanic Street, Kearsarge Street, and Lane Street – delivering service to new customers and connecting to existing sewer lines.
